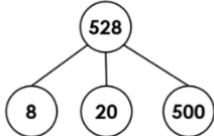


Year 5 Homework Grid (Autumn 1)

Science: We have been learning about Earth and space. Research astronauts such as: Neil Armstrong, Tim Peake, Valentina Tereshkova or Buzz Aldrin. Find out about why they are famous and include interesting facts. 	Geography: Create an informative poster about the 5 different climate zones on Earth (polar, temperate, arid, tropical, Mediterranean, mountains). 	Reading: Read some of your favourite book. Choose a character and draw them. Label what they are like. Use description to describe appearance and personality. Draw the front cover. Explain why this is your favourite book. 	English: Draw and describe your own magical world that could be on the other side of the wardrobe in The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe story. Think of things which you might see in the magical world and use adjectives to describe them. 
Spelling: Look at your weekly spellings list. These should have been sent home on Monday. Put each word into a sentence. Underline the spelling word. 	Maths: We have been learning about numbers up to 1 million. Come up with five of your own numbers with us to 6 digits. Partition the number by identifying what the value of each digit is. 	PSHE: Our topic is identity. Draw a picture of yourself and label 10 things that make up your own identity. What makes you unique? 	RE: We have been learning about the Bible, how it is used and how it reflects Christian beliefs. Retell your favourite Bible story and explain why it is important to Christians. Draw a picture to match the story.
