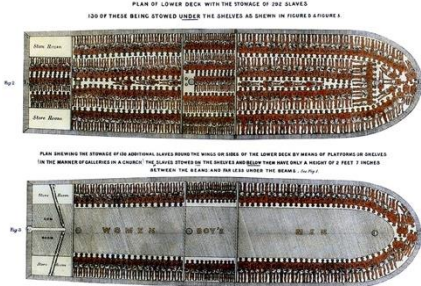
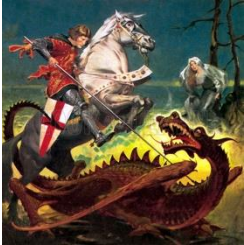


Year 5 Homework Grid (Autumn 2)

Please complete one piece of homework each week.

Homework needs to be in for Thursday each week and will be given out on a Friday.

Science: We are learning about materials and their properties. Go on a scavenger hunt around your home and list things that are: - solids - liquids - gases - metals - plastics - transparent (see through) 	History: We are learning about the Transatlantic Slave Trade. Write a short diary entry from the perspective of a slave on board a slave ship. Make sure to explain what the conditions are like. How are you treated? What is your job? How do you feel? 	Reading: Create a book review based on a book you have read. Here are some things to include: - title - author - summary of the story - outline the characters - why you enjoyed the book - how it could be improved - a rating out of 10 - a picture of the front cover 	Maths: Create 6 of your own 3 digit by 1 digit multiplication questions (e.g. 234 X 5). Find the answer to your own questions. Use the short multiplication method as shown below: $\begin{array}{r} 213 \\ \times 3 \\ \hline 639 \end{array}$ $213 \times 3 = 639$
Computing: Create an E-safety poster about staying safe online. 	English: Our new English topic is 'Legends'. One of the famous legends stories we have read is 'George and the Dragon'. Create a vocabulary bank of words to describe the dragon and Saint George. e.g. Saint George: heroic, mighty e.g. Dragon: lethal, scaly, crimson-red 	RE: We have been learning about how Christians celebrate Christmas around the world.
